**DAY 01 / APR 07 / MAY 05
MANILA / ROME**

**DAY 02 / APR 08 / MAY 06
ROME (D)**

Welcome to Rome! After airport formalities, meet and greet then transfer to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

**DAY 03 / APR 09 / MAY 07
ROME (ABF,D)**

Morning guided tour includes the Vatican to visit *St. Peter's Basilica* and *Square* and the *Vatican Museum*. Continue your sightseeing with the *Colosseum*, *Arch of Constantine*, *Vittorio Emanuele II Monument*, *Piazza Navona*, and toss a coin in the *Trevi Fountain* on the hope of returning to Rome. Free time to walk to the *Spanish Steps* and shop for luxurious branded goods.

**DAY 04 / APR 10 / MAY 08/
ROME – ASSISI (2 ½ HOURS)**

ASSISI – PISA (3 HOURS) (ABF,D)

Stop in Assisi the home town of the Beloved St. Francis. See the *Basilica of St. Francis* and the *Basilica of Santa Maria Degli Angeli*. Continue on to Pisa for a photo stop at the amazing *Leaning Tower* and the nearby *Cathedral*. Check in to your hotel.

PISA - MONACO (3 HOURS)**

MONACO-NICE (1 HOUR) (ABF,D)

We cross the border to France and stop at the principality of Monaco. See the *Annunciation Cathedral* where Prince Rainer & Princess Grace are buried. See the *Casino Monte Carlo*, *The Rock*, *Port Hercule* and *Larvotto Beach*. Later, Continue to Nice to see the *Masema Square*, *Promenade de Anglais* and the *Place Garibaldi* before dinner and check in.

**DAY 06 / APR 12 / MAY 10
NICE - BARCELONA
(7 HOURS) (ABF,D)**

Leave the French Riviera and cross over the Spanish border in your way to Barcelona Check in to your hotel upon arrival.

**DAY 07 / APR 13 / MAY 11
BARCELONA (ABF,D)**

Morning guided visit to the *Montserrat Monastery* to see the famous 12th century Romanesque carving of Virgen Moreneta, the Black Virgin Afterwards, see the *Plaza Espana*, *Plaza Real*, *Plaza Catalunya*, *Olympic Stadium* *Christopher Columbus Monument* *Arch of Triumph* and the *La Sagrada Familia Cathedral*, Barcelona's most famous landmark and Gaudi's unfinished masterpiece.

**DAY 08 / APR 14 / MAY 12
BARCELONA-LOURDES (5 HOURS) (ABF,D)**

After Lunch, return to France on your way to the major pilgrimage site in Europe- Lourdes. Check in to your Hotel. Rest of the day is free.

**DAY 09 / APR 15 / MAY 13
LOURDES (ABF,D)**

The day is free for private devotion. You may wish to go to the *Sanctuary* to visit the *Underground basilica*, walk the Station of the Cross take the Holy Bath, drink the water or wash your Face in the Grotto, or participate in the veneration of the sick pilgrim. Tonight, why not join the

LOURDES- ZARAGOSA (3 HOURS)

ZARAGOSA- BURGOS (3 HOURS) (ABF,D)

Cross the Spanish border on your way to Zaragoza and see the *basilica of Our Lady of the Pilar*, consider the Patroness of the country and the Spanish Civil Guard. Afterwards, dinner then check into your hotel in Burgos.

DAY 11 / APR 17 / MAY 15

BURGOS- SANTIAGO

DE COMPOSTELA (6 HOURS) (ABF,D)

This morning, visit the *Burgos gothic Cathedral*. Afterwards, drive to Santiago de Compostela, a World Heritage City and one of the most important places in Catholicism, for dinner and over night.

DAY 12 / APR 18 / MAY 16

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA -

FATIMA (5 HOURS) (ABF,D)

Your city tour of this is historical city will take you to the *Santiago de Compostela Cathedral*, *Plaza del Obradoiro*, *Monasterio de San Martin Pinario*, *Convento de San Francisco*, *Fuente de los Caballos* and *the Palacio de Raxoi*. Cross the border of Portugal and Drive to Fatima another pilgrimage center. Dinner the check in to your hotel.

DAY 13 / APR 19 / MAY 17

FATIMA- LISBON-FATIMA (ABF,D)

Drive to the capital of Portugal, Lisbon – see the Tagus River, *Marques de Pombal Square*, *Liberdade Avenue*, pass by *Belem Palace* official residence of the president of Portugal stop at *Belem tower*- icon of the Age of Discovery and the *Monument of the Discoveries* close by is *Jeronimos Monastery*, magnificent example of the Manuel style. See the *Baixa Praca do Comercio* and the *Suspension Bridge*. Return to Fatima for some free time for private devotion, you may explore the *Sanctuary* and the *Great White Basilica* and maybe, join the candlelight procession in the evening.

DAY 14 / APR 20 / MAY 18

FATIMA- AVILA (4 HOURS)

AVILA-MADRID (1 HOURS) (ABF,D)

After breakfast, cross the border to Spain and stop in Avila- completely encircled by 11th century walls an birthplace of St. Theresa of Avila and visit the *Convent of St. Theresa* and the *Cathedral*. Continue to the capital city, Madrid. Overnight and dinner at the hotel.

DAY 15 / APR 21 / MAY 19

MADRID (ABF,D)

This morning, go on a half day city sightseeing tour of this beautiful city and see the *Puerto del sol*, *Gran Via*, *Cibeles Fountain*, *Alcala Gate*, *Santiago Bernabeu Stadium*, *Plaza de Espanya*, *Prado Museum*, highlighted by a visit to the *Royal Palace*. Balance of the day is free for shopping.
