18 Day Tour of Croatia, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Hungary, Slovakia, Czech Republic and Poland



Departure: April 05, 2018

DAY 01 / APR 05 MANILA / ZAGREB

Depart Manila on board a prestigious airline to Zagreb, Croatia. Enjoy in flight meals and entertainment.

DAY 02 / APR 06 ZAGREB - SPLIT (D)

Welcome to Croatia. After immigration clearance at the airport. Proceed to the exit where your representative will meet and assist you. Transfer to Split for dinner and overnight.

DAY 03 / APR 07 SPLIT - DUBROVNIK (BD)

Split the second largest city in Croatia. Walking tour to see the historic inner city which shows off the Roman Emperor *Diocletian's Palace*, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. See the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, it's Renaissance and Gothic structures. *Jupiter's Temple*, the *Peristyle* and the *Cathedral*. Balance of the day is for shopping. Transfer to Dubrovnik for dinner and overnight.

DAY 04 / APR 08 DUBROVNIK - MEDJUGORJE (BD)

This morning, see the city of Dubrovnik, the "Pearl of the Adriatic" and famous for the 'Game of Thrones' film location. Upon arrival, discover the *Old City*, also included in UNESCO's World Heritage List, surrounded by mighty walls and fortresses. See the *Stradum*, the elegant main street with *Onofrio's Fountain*, the *Franciscan Monastery* with the ancient pharmacy, *Orlando's Column*, *Church of St. Blaise* and the *Cathedral*. Afterwards, drive back to Medjugorje for a visit to the *Apparition Hill* and free time for private devotion.

DAY 05 / APR 09 MEDJUGORJE - ZAGREB (BD)

Long distance to Zagreb. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day is free.

DAY 06 / APR 10 ZAGREB - BUDAPEST (BD)

Sightseeing tour of the City. Explore the medieval *Upper Town*, walk along the cobbled stone streets, visit *St. Mark's Church* and see the red roof building. Transfer to Budapest for dinner and overnight.

DAY 07 / APR 11 BUDAPEST (BD)

Morning commence your sightseeing tour which features the *Castle Hill*, the *Fisherman's Bastion* on enjoy a panoramic view of the city and the *Parliament House*, the 13th century *Matthias Coronation Church*, the *Citadel of Mount Gellert* and the *Heroes Square*.

DAY 08 / APR 12 BUDAPEST - BRATISLAVA - PRAGUE (BD)

Afterwards, drive to Slovakia on your way to Bratislava for a walking tour of the *Old Town* and you will view from the coach the *Presidential Palace*, *Bratislava Castle*, then continue drive to Prague.

DAY 09 / APR 13 PRAGUE (BD)

The walking tour of this beautiful city starts in the *Praque Castle* and see *St. Vitus Cathedral*, *St. George Basilica*, the *Old Royal Palace*, *Golden Lane* and to the *Daliborka Tower*. Then continue your walk crossing the *St. Charles Bridge* and visit the *Church of our Lady of Victorious* to see the *Sto. Nino De*

Praga. Afterwards, on to the *Astronomical Clock* in the *Old Town* where the tour ends. The rest of the day is free.

DAY 10 / APR 14 PRAGUE - VIENNA (BD)

Cross over the Austrian border on your way to Vienna. Upon arrival, commence your half day city sightseeing tour highlighted by a visit to the *Schonbrunn Palace*, afterwards, dinner and check in to your hotel.

DAY 11 / APR 15 VIENNA - CRACOW (BD)

After breakfast, go on a long distance transfer to Cracow, Poland. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day is free.

DAY 12 / APR 16 CRACOW (BD)

Full day sightseeing today starts with a drive to Lagiewniki to visit the *Shrine of the Divine Mercy of Sister Faustina*. Then continue to the city and walk along the famous *Courtyard of the Jagiellonian University* and the *Old Town*. Later, visit the famous *Wieliczka Saltmines*. The mine's attractions include dozens of statues, three chapels and an entire cathedral that has been carved out of the rock salt by the miners. Return to the city in time for dinner.

DAY 13 / APR 17 CRACOW - LEGNICA - CZESTOCHOWA (BD)

This morning, drive to Legnica to visit the *St. Hyacinth Shrine*. Continue to Czestochowa for dinner and overnight.

DAY 14 / APR 18 CZESTOCHOWA - AUSCHWITZ - WADOWICE - WROCLAW (BD)

Visit to *Jasna Gora Monastery* for Holy Mass and to visit the *Black Madonna*, venerated as the "Queen of Poland". In the afternoon continue to Auschwitz to visit the *Concentration Camp*, a chilling reminder of the Holocaust. Proceed to Wadowice to visit the birthplace of St. Pope John Paul at the *Church of Our Lady of Sacrifice*. Continue to Wroclaw for dinner and overnight.

DAY 15 / APR 19 WROCLAW - WARSAW (BD)

Long distance transfer to Warsaw. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel. Balance of the day is free.

DAY 16 / APR 20 WARSAW (BD)

After breakfast, enjoy this great opportunity to learn the history of Poland's capital. See the *Old Town*, an excellent example of compromise between the historic values and modern needs - art galleries, shops, charming restaurants, etc. See the historical sights of Warsaw - the *Ghetto Memorial*, the *Monument of Warsaw Uprising*, the *Tomb of Unknown Soldier*, *Chopin's Monument* and the *Belvedere Palace*. Visit the *Grave of Irena Sandler*, a visit to *Chopin's Memorial Park* and *St. John's Cathedral* (Holy Mass). Visit to the *Lazeinki Royal Palace and Park*. Dinner and overnight in Warsaw.

DAY 17 / APR 21 WARSAW / MANILA (B)

Departure transfer to the airport for your flight back to Manila.

DAY 18 / APR 22 MANILA

Arrival in Manila. HOME SWEET HOME!
