**DAY 01
DEPART MANILA**

We leave Manila on board a prestigious airline. Enjoy inflight services and meals.

**DAY 02
ARRIVAL COPENHAGEN, Denmark /
REYKJAVIK, Iceland (D)**

On arrival in Copenhagen, Denmark you will pass immigration and customs. Then transfer to your gate for your connecting flight to Reykjavik, the capital of Iceland. On arrival to Keflavik Airport, you will be met & transfer your accommodation in Reykjavik.

**DAY 03
THE GOLDEN CIRCLE (BLD)**

Begin your journey on the classic "Golden Circle" route, home to some of Iceland's most popular attractions, including **Pingvellir National Park**, the hot springs of the **Haukadalur geothermal area** and see **Strokkur Geysir**. After the majestic **Gullfoss waterfall** we stop and see some **Icelandic horses** then on to old implosion **crater of Kerið**. Then continue your drive along the south coast and visit the graceful **Seljalandsfoss waterfall**—where you can walk behind the cascade—and the equally impressive **Skógafoss waterfall**. Spend the night in the Vik area.

**DAY 04
GLACIERS AND ICEBERGS (BLD)**

Visit the black volcanic beach near Vik and the **rock formations of Dyrhólaey and Reynisdrangar** before heading to **Skaftafell**, part of the immense **Vatnajökull National Park** and a place of great natural beauty. Then, on your way towards Höfn, take a break at the amazing **Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon**, where you can join a boat ride among the maze of floating icebergs (optional) or time to walk along the beach. Enjoy **LOBSTER Dinner**. Spend the night in the Höfn area.

**DAY 05
EAST FJORDS & LAKE MÝVATN (BLD)**

Your drive along East Iceland today is characterised by spectacular fjords, tranquil fishing villages and sweeping landscapes. On arrival to the otherworldly Lake Mývatn, you have an abundance of unusual natural wonders to explore, including the **Krafla volcano**, the curiously-coloured **Námaskarð pass**, the fascinating lava formations at maze of **Dimmuborgir** and the lunar-like pseudo-craters at **Skútustaðir**. Enjoy **Myvatn Bath** includes entrance and towel.

**DAY 06
THE CAPITAL OF THE NORTH (BLD)**

Spend the first half of the day exploring more of the sights around Lake Mývatn before driving towards the beautiful **Goðafoss waterfall**, the charming town of **Akureyri**—nicknamed "The Capital of North Iceland"—and the **Glaumbær turf farm museum**.

**DAY 07
HISTORY AND HOT SPRINGS (BLD)**

Head back to Reykjavik today. Notable sights along the way include the **Grábrók volcanic crater**, the Icelandic Settlement Centre in **Borgarnes**, **Deildartunguhver**—the largest hot spring in Europe—and the beautiful **Hraunfossar waterfalls** and **Barnafoss waterfalls**. History or Nordic literature buffs may also find it worthwhile to stop at the medieval research institution of **Snorrastofa** at **Reykholt**, where **Snorri Sturluson** wrote the **Saga Heimskringla** in the 13th century. Spend the night in Fossotel or central Reykjavik.

**DAY 08
REYKJAVIK (BL) City & Blue Lagoon**

Morning sightseeing of the city of Reykjavik, the capital of Iceland, Reykjavik or 'Steamy Cove', is named after its geothermal location, is a vibrant city with a lively culture and fun-filled nightlife. On this tour you will get the highlights of the history and culture of Iceland's capital including **Hallgrímskirkja Church**, town Hall, Parliament, Hofdi House – where Reagan and Gorbachev met in the summit that took place in 1986 and the **Harpa Concert Hall**. See **Perlan** the dome built on warm water tanks and famous for its viewing deck. Experience the **Blue Lagoon**, a unique spa where you can enjoy relaxing in warm geothermal seawater in the fresh air, surrounded by a moon-like lava field

**DAY 09
REYKJAVIK / MANILA**

Transfer by shuttle to Keflavik Airport in time for your departure flight back to Manila.
