

**DAY 1 / OCT 10 (We)
DEPART MANILA**

We leave Manila on board a prestigious airline. Enjoy inflight services and meals

DAY 02 / OCT 11 (Th)

ARRIVAL COPENHAGEN, Denmark / REYKJAVIK, Iceland (D)

On arrival in Copenhagen, Denmark you will pass immigration and customs. Take your connecting flight to Reykjavik, the capital of Iceland. On arrival to Keflavik Airport, you will be met & transfer to your Reykjavik accommodation for dinner.

DAY 03 / OCT 12 (Fr)

THE GOLDEN CIRCLE (B L)

Begin your journey on the classic 'Golden Circle' route, home to some of Iceland's most popular attractions, including UNESCO designated world heritage site **Pingvellir National Park** is an attraction of great historical, geological and cultural significance. Located in a rift valley where the Eurasian and North American tectonic plates meet. See the majestic **Gullfoss waterfall**, stop at the **Haukadalur Geothermal** -home of "The Great Geysir" hot spring, which all geysers are named after, this area is an impressive collage of bubbling mud pools, hissing steam vents, and colourful algae deposits. Check out **Strokkur geyser** puts on quite the show every few minutes blasting boiling water high up into the air. After a short stop at **Faxi waterfall** and its fish ladder, allowing salmon to "climb" upstream, we reach **Skálholt cathedral** and the archaeological museum beneath it. Rich in history, Skálholt was the epicentre of culture, politics and education in Iceland for eight centuries. Overnigt Reykjavik.

DAY 04 / OCT 13 (Sa)

SNAEFELLSNES PENINSULA AND CAVE EXPLORATION (B L)

This tour takes you west from Reykjavik on a scenic route to Borgarfjörður and the village of **Borgarnes** where a short stop will be made for refreshments. Shortly after entering **Snaefellsnes Peninsula**, you'll get a chance to spot local wildlife at the beach which is home to a seal colony and variety of sea birds. Next up is a visit to the idyllic **Arnarstapi village** where you'll take a walk to view the extraordinary landscape along the precipitous shoreline before continuing to the small village of Hellnar where a break will be made. After lunch the tour continues to **Vatnshellir lava tube cave** that lies in the **Snaefellsjökull National Park**, close to where Jules Verne located his entrance for the "Journey to the Centre of the Earth". Explore into a subterranean world of stalactites, stalagmites, and strange lava formations that, in the glow of your headlight, form eerie shapes and shadows flickering across the walls of the cave. After, drive to **Djúpalónssandur**, a tranquil, black-pebbled beach that offers beautiful views out to the sea and fascinating history. Then to **Grundarfjörður fishing village**, home to one of the peninsula's most iconic and photographed landmarks, the symmetrical mountain **Kirkjufell** that towers 1500 ft. up from the shoreline. Onroute lies across **Berserkjahraun lava fields** that according to Viking legends was where two Swedish "Berserks" forged Iceland's first road and over to the south side of the peninsula through **Vatnaleið** pass. Overnight Reykjavik.

DAY 05 / OCT 14 (Su)

SOUTH ICELAND, WATERFALLS AND BLACK SAND BEACH (B D)

Your South Iceland journey will take you through the country's lush farmlands, flanked by rugged mountains,

glaciers and volcanoes of the interior on one side and vast Atlantic ocean views on the other. Our first stop is at **Seljalandsfoss**, a very photogenic waterfall that plunges from ancient sea cliffs down over 60 m to a shallow Pool. It is possible to take a walk behind the waterfall and enjoy the beautiful scenery from there. The water comes from the infamous volcano and glacier **Eyjafjallajökull**. Then stop at the **Skogafoss Waterfall**. It's also 60 m in height and is considered by many to be one of the largest and most beautiful waterfalls in Iceland. Just outside the town of Vík í Mýrdal (or just Vík to the locals) you will visit the soaring basalt rock formation known as **Reynisdrangar** and the black sand beach of **Reynisfjara**. After that we go to **Skaftafell Nature Reserve** in the Vatnajökull National Park, where we'll have a short stop. The glacier tongues there give the national park a majestic fairy tale scenery. We enjoy dinner upon arrival. During the evening, and into the night, we look out for the **Northern Lights** when conditions allow. Our accommodation in the Country Hotel Gerði (summer) and Country Hotel Smyrlabjörg (winter). The rooms all have bathroom. Free WiFi is available in the dining room, and the restaurant uses mainly local products on the menu. During winter time, if the weather is good skies clear, you might be able to experience the amazing northern lights flickering in the sky.

DAY 06 / OCT 15 (Mo)

GLACIER & ICEBERGS (B L)

After breakfast we spend more time at **Jokulsarlon Glacier Lagoon** and from Apr-Oct it's possible to enjoy an optional 40-minute boat ride among icebergs of all shapes. We also take a walk alongside the lake and on the black sand shores and look for seals which may be spotted in the lagoon. **Jokulsarlon** has been the film location of many Hollywood movies. It is located at the end of an outlet glacier of the great **Vatnajökull Glacier**. Huge pieces of ice calve from the glacier and end up floating in the lagoon and out to sea. After we have enjoyed the lagoon with its icebergs we will drive back to Reykjavik.

DAY 07 / OCT 16 (Tu)

CITY TOUR & BLUE LAGOON (B L)

Morning sightseeing of the city of Reykjavik, the capital of Iceland, Reykjavik or 'Steamy Cove', is named after its geothermal location, is a vibrant city with a lively culture and fun-filled nightlife. On this tour you will get the highlights of the history and culture of Iceland's capital including **Hallgrímskirkja Church, town Hall, Parliament, Hofdi House** – where Reagan and Gorbachev met in the summit that took place in 1986 and the **Harpa Concert Hall**. See **Perlan** the dome built on warm water tanks and famous for its viewing deck. Experience the **Blue Lagoon**, a unique spa where you can enjoy relaxing in warm geothermal seawater in the fresh air, surrounded by a moon-like lava field (includes towels Spend the night in Reykjavik.

DAY 10 / OCT 17(We)

REYKJAVIK, Iceland / MANILA (B)

Transfer by shuttle to Keflavik Airport in time for your departure flight back to Manila.
